<u>Place</u>: immediately after the noun it relates to: Eg. the table that I painted

Relative pronoun for humans: who, whom, whose

<u>Place</u>: immediately after the noun it relates to: Eg. the girl whom I met....

**INTERROGATIVE PRONOUNS**: who?, whom?, whose?, what?, which?,

**<u>DEMONSTRATIVE PRONOUNS</u>**: this, these, that, those, such, same

**INDEFINITE PRONOUNS**: any, many, one, anybody, anything, something, some, none, somebody, each, all

# **GENDER**:

The PROnoun has NO GENDER in Hungarian, as witnessed in the personal PRONOUN 3<sup>rd</sup> Person he/she/it in Hungarian is JUST <mark>Ő</mark> or they <mark>ŐK</mark>.
