Relative pronoun for things: what, which, that

Place: immediately after the noun it relates to: Eg. the table **that** I painted

Relative pronoun for humans: who, whom, whose

Place: immediately after the noun it relates to: Eg. the girl **whom** I met....

INTERROGATIVE PRONOUNS: who?, whom?, whose?, what?, which?,

DEMONSTRATIVE PRONOUNS: this, these, that, those, such, same

INDEFINITE PRONOUNS: any, many, one, anybody, anything, something, some, none, somebody, each, all

GENDER:

The PRONoun has **NO GENDER** in Hungarian, as witnessed in the personal PRONOUN 3rd Person **he/she/it** in Hungarian is JUST **Ő** or they **ŐK**.
